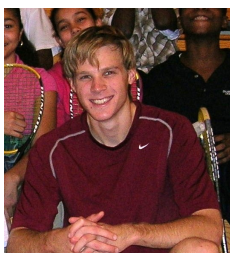
Junior Development Endowment Fund Grant from U.S. Squash
